CAPITAL

A contemporary art exhibition within Lund 2014

As part of the CAPITAL exhibition, the works of twenty international and national artists will be on view at the Skånska hypoteksföreningen [mortgage bank] in Lund. CAPITAL, the title of the show, elucidates the tension among three concepts: 1) the idea of a “Capital of Culture”, 2) art and culture as cultural capital, and 3) the historical and political context of the exhibition space. Various art forms – installations, videos, photographs, individual pieces, constructions, interactive projects and site-specific performances – make up the exhibition. They aim at encountering a wide audience and encouraging dialogue or participation. The goal of the exhibition is to create specific moods and open the door to conversation between art and observers and among the people in the city. For the project, the contemporary art will be placed in both a commercial milieu and a public space. The exhibition will be on display in the historic bank building and its surroundings – at Lund Cathedral and Kulturen [Museum of Cultural History] and in Lundagård Park. The project wants to raise awareness regarding the processes and the development of a city’s identity.

FIVE/TEN/TWENTY

During the exhibitions three days all the artists will be present, in order to make the most of this unique opportunity, visitors to the exhibition are invited to an artist marathon. Each of the twenty artists is allotted five minutes for a visual presentation consisting of ten images, which are projected on a wall in the building’s exciting cellar locales. The artists use the five minutes in any way they wish. The public may encounter everything from performance art to artistic biographies in combination with the images on the wall. This will happen on Saturday the 13th of October at 8 p.m. in the cellar of Skånska hypoteksföreningen

CAPITAL is arranged as a part of Lund for European Capital of Culture 2014. It is financed by Lunds Kommun, kultur- och fritidsförvaltningen and Lund 2014 and in cooperation with Galleri 5, Historiska Museet, Kulturen, Lundafastigheter, Lunds domkyrka, Lunds Konsthall, Pictura, Paulssons och Statens fastighetsverk.
